



Get ready to choose your classes

Dear Stevenson Student,

Our names are Marie, Nairi and Asia, and we're your Stevenson College academic advisers. You'll be hearing from us over the next several weeks as you prepare for Orientation and enrollment this July.

If you are **attending** Summer Orientation on July 28, you will be adding your classes that afternoon. If you're **not attending** Orientation, you will most likely enroll on Monday, August 7th, though there are some exceptions. Your enrollment appointment will be available for viewing on your [My.UCSC student portal](#) by mid-July.

Please read and complete each of these steps (all detailed in the [Transfer Advising Guide](#)) before your enrollment day:

1: Prepare to Qualify for Your Major.

Your primary focus for the next weeks should be familiarizing yourself with your major requirements and contacting your major advisers if you need assistance with prerequisites or planning.

2: Understand UCSC's Graduation Requirements.

Transfer students are still responsible for all University and General Education requirements, and must earn 180 credits. Not all transfers arrive with these requirements completed, so it's important to understand what might apply to you.

3: Choose and Enroll in Your Fall Classes.

UCSC's enrollment system may be different than what you've experienced before. Understand how to build your schedule and use the shopping cart.

4: Review Important Information & Resources.

You're not alone! Learn about many of the services available to help support you.

The [Summer Orientation Checklist](#) contains helpful Summer to-dos and deadlines, and will be useful whether or not you are attending Orientation.
